TERMS & CONDITIONS

- ▶ The competition begins on 14th August 2010 at 7:30 am Malaysian time, and ends on 3rd September 2010 at 4:00pm Malaysian time. All entries must be received within this time period in order to be considered for prizes.
- ▶ By registering for this contest, each participant agrees to the Official Rules and Regulations and warrants that his or her entry complies with all requirements set out in the Official Rules and Regulations.

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Who may enter

This contest is only open for students in Taylor's University College.

How to enter

- ▶ Participation involves registering for and going on a trip to the Forest Reserve Institute of Malaysia (FRIM), hereafter referred to as the site, on Saturday, 14th August 2010.
- ▶ The cost of RM20 for the trip includes transportation, snack and a T-shirt and is payable on registering.
- ▶ Participants will use their own cameras and be fully responsible for their equipment at the site.
- ▶ The photographs for entry must be captured at the site.
- ▶ Each participant is allowed to submit a maximum of 2 entries.
- ▶ Each participant can qualify for 1 prize only.
- ▶ Each entry must be submitted together with an entry form containing personal and contact details as well as a description of the technique (e.g. ISO, Aperture, Shutter Speed) used to create the photograph.

- ▶ All entries must be submitted to fyesocit@gmail.com before the contest ends.
- ▶ Each entry must comply with the following requirements (the Photograph Requirements):
 - ❖ The photograph, in its entirety, must be an original work created solely by the entrant.
 - ❖ The photograph must be in digital format with minimum 3000 x 2400 dimension or 7.2 Megapixel.
 - ❖ The photograph can be edited with photo editing software.
 - ❖ The photograph must be taken in Forest Research Institute Malaysia (FRIM) anytime within the contest period.
 - ❖ A **caption not more than 25 words** that captures the relationship between the photographed subject and the concept of Green Computing must be included in the image.
 - ❖ The submitted photograph must not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity.
 - ❖ If the photograph contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, and/or if any persons appear in the photograph, the entrant is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the photograph, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the exhibition and use of the photograph in the manner set forth in these Official Rules without additional compensation.
 - ❖ The entry must not contain obscene, provocative, defamatory, profane, sexually explicit, or otherwise objectionable or inappropriate content.

Contest Prizes

- ▶ There are 3 main prizes and 9 consolation prizes.
- ▶ No prize transfer, assignment, or substitution by winners is permitted.
- ▶ If a prize (or part of a prize) is unavailable, the Sponsor reserves the right to substitute the original prize (or that part of the prize) with an alternative prize to the equal monetary value and/or specification.

Judging

- ▶ The entries will be judged by a panel comprising sponsors and photography experts.
- ▶ The judges' decision is final and binding.

Notification of Prize Winners

- ▶ Prize winners will be notified in October.
- ▶ Notification shall be by e-mail and/or telephone.
- ▶ If the Organizer is unable to contact a potential winner, the Organizer has the option to disqualify such a potential winner and select an alternate winner.
- ▶ Prize winners will be required to attend the prize-giving ceremony to receive their prizes.

License

The Organizer retains ownership and all rights to future use of all the submitted photos. By entering the Contest, all entrants grant an irrevocable perpetual, nonexclusive license to the Organizer to reproduce, distribute, display, and create derivative works of the entries (along with a name credit) in any media now or hereafter known, including, but not limited to: display at a potential exhibition of winners; publication of a calendar; publication of promotional materials or online publications highlighting entries or winners of the Contest. Display or publication of any entry on the Organizer's website does not indicate the entrant will be selected as a winner. The Organizer will not be required to pay any additional consideration or seek any additional approval in connection with such use. Each entrant grants to the Organizer the unrestricted right to use all statements made in connection with the Contest, and pictures of Contest entrants, or choose not to do so, at their sole discretion.
